I. INTRODUCTION

GSJA Victorious Worship Family is one of the churches under an organization called the Gereja Sidang Jemaat Allah (GSJA) or Assemblies of God. GSJA is currently the largest Pentecostal church in the world which has a following of around + 65 million people worldwide. In Indonesia, GSJA is a continuation of Bethel Indies Zending which was recognized by the government on April 4, 1941. Then the name changed to "The Assemblies of God in Indonesia" which was ratified by the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Indonesia on February 10, 1951 with legal entity No.YA8 / 11 / 16. The founders were three American missionaries, namely: Kenneth G.Short, Ralph M.Devin, and Raymond Arthur Busby. Ralph Mitchell Devin as Chairman until 1959[1]. In 1998, Pastor John Ingatum, based on God's vision, opened a new church in Makassar without sponsorship. The fellowship started in June 2000 at his own house with eight people including the pastor and wife. A month later it increased to an average of 15 people. Then, this fellowship was inaugurated under the name GSJA "Victorious Worship Family". The church had experienced many changes from year to year, and at the age of 15 it finally had its own place, namely at Graha Victorious Makassar. However, even though it is

22 years old, the church does not yet have an official website in this digital age.

Some people will say a church does not need a website, but the fact says otherwise. There are many benefits that come for a church by having a website. Websites are a great way to keep in touch with members of the church especially in a case like today where all prayers must remain online. Benefit to having a website is that it can significantly reduce the number of phone calls and inquiries regarding service times and basic information about the church. The admin can post the service time on the website. Having a website can also give a church a way to online donations, online consultations, and Bible study classes that are conducted online. This system is proposed to fulfill these objectives To fulfill the need of a digital technology that can support church services and to keep engaging with the member of the church interactively

II. LITERATURE REVIEW

This section is to explain the purpose related or concepts used in the development of this thesis *Gereja Sidang Jemaat Allah* or Assemblies of God. The Assemblies of God in Indonesia began with the arrival of three missionaries from the United States, namely: Kenneth G. Short, Ralph M. Devin, and Raymond A. Busby who worked under the supervision of the Bethel Temple Mission, in Indonesia until the birth of the Assemblies of God in Indonesia which is the official successor of the so-called Bethel Indies Mission, in January 1951.

In 1951, Ralph Devin sent Leonard Lanphear and Harold Carlbloom to Minahasa on two mission, which is:

- 1. Opening Assemblies of God churches in Minahasa
- 2. Established a Bible school as a "factory" to produce Gospel Ministers in Minahasa

Lanphear and Carlbloom ware invited to be speaker at a revival services (*Kebaktian Kebangunan Rohani*) sponsored by a prayer group led by J.D. Tumengkol at the *Tonsea Lama*. At the end of the service, J.D. Tumengkol and other members of the prayer group decided to join

the Assemblies of God of Indonesia. Finally, a church was built which was built on the land belonging to the Julis Ratag family. This church is now known as the first *Sidang Jemaat Allah* Church in Minahasa. However, the second mission could be realized in 1952, precisely in May at Kakaskasen. Known as the Minahasa Bible Institute

Darrel and Dianne Wood wanted to expand the GSJA ministry in the villages of Central Sulawesi, and finally established the Maranatha Bible School at Palu in June 1993. The presence of the Maranatha Bible School has had a positive impact on GSJA's ministry in Central Sulawesi. Hundreds of kilometers from Palu, in Palopo City, South Sulawesi, Henly Kasenda, Pastor of the GSJA Palopo with the support of the Gospel Ministers and Regional Government (Badan Pengurus Daerah) South Sulawesi opened the Talitakum Bible School on October 11, 1991.

Pdt. John Ingatum grew up under the shepherd, Pdt. Henly Kasenda a Pastor at GSJA Talitakum Palopo. Pdt. John Ingatum started his ministry from leading young people, then became a lecturer at the Talitakum Bible School (STAT) Palopo. In 1998, through the God's vision he left Palopo and went to Makassar to opened a new church in Makassar without sponsorship. Started with eight people fellowship, including he and his wife. Then increasing to an average of 15 people. Finally, it was inaugurated under the name GSJA Victorious Worship Family.




Figure 1. Use Case Diagram




Figure 3. List of Pastors User Interface Design




Figure 4. Member Dashboard User Interface Design
